**REGULATIONS**

1. **Organizers** – Ministry of Sport and Youth of Georgia.
  - Tbilisi city Hall.
  - Georgian Chess Federation.
  - ACP (Association of Chess Professionals)
2. **Tournaments :**
  - **A Open tournament** for any player (Fide rating 2001 and more, Fide titled players)
  - **B Open tournament** for any player (Fide rating 2000 and under and without rating)
3. **Mode** – 9 rounds, Swiss system, Fide rules are applied.
  - The time limit is: A Open tournament - 40 moves in 90 minutes, followed by 30 minutes for the rest of the game. An increment of 30 seconds per move, starting from 1 move will be added after each move. B Open tournament - 90 minutes for the game. An increment of 30 seconds per move, starting from 1 move will be added after each move.
  - Default time – 15 mins.
  - By taking part in the tournament, the players agree to the possible anti-cheating check-ups, in accordance with the FIDE Anti-cheating guidelines.
  - Appeals committee (5 members) will be selected during the opening.
